English language proficiency level 2. Identified skill needs 3. Performance level <p style="text-align: center;">Intervention/Enrichment</p> <p>Students in Intervention will be provided differentiated targeted learning/enrichment opportunities based on assessment data results and identified area of needs. Enrichment students will work on practice and apply activities such as: Accelerated Reader, Accelerated Math, writing, science or social studies projects, and technology.</p> |
