Capturing Hearts

Learn how to create high-achieving classrooms by strengthening students' connectedness to each other. You'll walk away with activities you can do with you students on day one.

English Learner Strategies

Learn instructional strategies which may be utilized in any class to better assist you with your English Learner students. The strategies shared will be focused from the Project GLAD (Guided Lanaguage Acquisition Design).

Grade Level Specific Workshops offered during Specific Sessions

Behavior Doctor Grades TK-3, 4-8

Learn strategies from Dr. Laura to address targeted student behaviors. Learn how to revise the environment, replace the behavior, and reframe your response to the trigger, target, and impact. Strategies shared are appropriate to use with General Ed and Special Ed students.

8 Mathematical Practices Grades TK-2, 3-5, 6-8

Get a deeper understanding of the 8 Mathematical Practices and how to integrate them into your math instruction. Leave with concrete strategies on what the practice looks like and sounds like in the classroom.

Math Talk Grades TK-2, 3-5, 6-8

Increase your students' engagement and understanding of mathematical concepts using this easy to implement strategy. Get your students talking Math!

GO Math Grades 6-8

Integrate the 8 Mathematical Practices with the Math problems in our GO Math curriculum. Leave with concrete lessons you can implement with your students.

Repeated Workshops offered for Grades TK – 8 during all Sessions 1 - 4

Aeries – Discipline Screen and Gradebook set up

The look of Aeries has been updated. Come learn and review how to input parent communications, record class progressive discipline, and set up your gradebook. Chromebooks will be provided and time will be given to allow you to set up your gradebooks during this session.

Google Integration

Come learn the basics regarding how to set up and use the fun and available Google apps such as Drive, Docs, Sheets, and Classroom. This session will help you with the integration of Google into your classroom instruction.

Personal Math Trainer

Come learn how to implement the Go Math Personal Math Trainer. This is the computerized program of your Core Math curriculum which may be used to meet the individual needs of your students. Participants will be given an opportunity to set up their classroom in the Personal Math Trainer.

Restorative Practices

Learn strategies you can use to enhance PBIS implementation in your school and classroom.

Student Engagement

Learn how to encourage independent thinking in your classroom! This is a hands-on workshop exploring inquiry, the concepts of maker spaces, and the idea of the Genius Hour. You will receive ready to use task cards for your classroom.
