Dear Contractor,

As you are aware Senate Bill 854 is now in effect. This bill requires all contractors who wish to do business with a public entity on any project \$ 1,000.00 or more to be registered with the DIR (Department of Industrial Relations).

All of our bid and RFP advertisements will now include the following language:

Bidders are advised that this contract is a public work for purposes of the California Labor Code, which requires payment of prevailing wages. Wage rates can be obtained from the Department of Industrial Relations at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/dprevagedetermination.htm> As of March 1, 2015 all contractors bidding on a public works project must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. <http://www.dir.ca.gov/public-works/publicworks.html>

All of our bid documents will now include the following language as well as provide a space on the bid or RFP form for the contractors DIR registration number.

As of March 1, 2015 all contractors bidding on a public works project must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 <http://www.dir.ca.gov/public-works/publicworks.html>

In the event the project is under the current legal bid limit, the contractor will be asked to provide the DIR registration number during the quoting process. This number will be reflected on the Purchase Order.
